

**ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION
UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK OPERATOR DESIGNATION FORM**

Title 18 Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) 78, *Underground Storage Tanks*, includes an operator training program, which went into effect in July 2012. Underground Storage Tank (UST) operator training is mandatory for Alaska UST system owners and operators, who must be trained and certified by December 2012. The Class A and Class B Operators must be designated to the state, in writing (*18 AAC 78.008(b)*) within 30 days of assignment to the position (*18 AAC 78.008(i)*).

CLASS A – Class A operators include owners or employees who have primary responsibility to operate and maintain UST systems. The focus is on the broader aspects of the underground storage tank requirements.

CLASS B – Class B operators have “daily on-site responsibilities” and an in-depth understanding of the operation, maintenance, leak detection monitoring and recordkeeping of UST systems.
