TAKEN OUT-OF-SERVICE or TEMPORARY CLOSURE



An Owner of an underground storage tank (UST) system is required to notify the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) for any UST system installed or in service, *Taken Out-Of-Service* or *Temporarily Closed*, in accordance with Title 18 Alaska Administrative Code (AAC) *Underground Storage Tanks*. "*Taken Out-Of-Service*" means a tank is empty, vented and secured. "*Temporary Closure*" means a UST system may contain petroleum product but is not currently in use (but may not be kept in this status for longer than three months).

A UST system in **Taken Out-of-Service (TOS)** status must not contain more than one inch (2.5 centimeters) of petroleum. A UST system in **Temporary Closure (TC)** status that may contain free petroleum product is not permitted be in TC status for more than three months. A UST system that does not meet regulatory and industry standards *is not permitted* to be out-of-service for more than 12 months before permanent closure is required.
